

5 Steps To Choosing Your New Stove

At Green Shop Gomshall, we want to make choosing a stove simpler by providing you with the following information. Follow the steps below for a better idea.

Step 1:

For deciding the heat output needed for your room, use calculation;

$$L \times H \times W \text{ (meters)} / 14 = \text{Kilo Watt (kW) output needed.}$$

Step 2:

Check with local authority if you live in a smoke control area. Many models can be used in these areas.

Step 3:

Wood or Multifuel?

Wood is an abundant resource in Surrey and is carbon neutral. It creates a more dramatic effect with a pleasant smell.

Other fuels are more expensive but burn hotter for longer.

Step 4:

If you have an existing chimney breast we can install the stove by lining the chimney with a stainless steel, flexible liner so long as the opening is large enough to accommodate the stove with sufficient air gaps so the stove can effectively heat the room. Hetas recommend 150mm (6") either side and 300mm (12") above — see diagram. If you don't have these

clearances then it may be possible to raise the lintel and/or increase the width to form a suitable opening for the stove. An inset/cassette stove might be more appealing, as less constructional work is needed. Note that access to the chimney pot is required, normally accessed by roof ladders.




If you do not have an existing chimney, we can install a twin wall chimney system through the roof or through the external wall — See diagrams to the right.

Step 5:

Stove choice is entirely up to you. Traditional or contemporary? Free standing or inset/cassette? There is a huge range

of stoves so do take your time and do not hesitate to ask a member of the team for any advise.
